



Pencil Holder Craft Project

Project Level: Easy

Supplies Needed:

- 1 sheet of craft paper, cut to 9 ¼ x 6 ¼ size
- 1 empty Crystal Light Lemonade container – plastic cylinder - paper removed
- 1 9 ¼ inch strip of ribbon (optional)
- Adhesive (glue stick)



1. Remove Crystal Light paper packaging and any glue from cylinder before starting. Ensure the surface is clean.
2. Cut craft paper to 9 ¼ x 6 ¼ size. This will provide about ½ inch overlap with the paper.
3. Glue complete back side of the paper.
4. Place paper on the cylinder, working carefully to line up the paper at the top rim.
5. Slowly roll the paper onto the cylinder using the palm of your hand to smooth the surface and adhere it to the cylinder.
6. Press firmly with your thumb along the seam. Add any extra glue to ensure it holds in place.
7. Optional Step: To add a finishing touch to your pencil holder, cut a strip of matching ribbon 9 ¼ inch long.
8. Apply glue or adhesive to the back of the ribbon.
9. Carefully place at the top of the cylinder along the rim. Press firmly with thumb at the seam to ensure it holds in place.
10. Viola, you have a fabulous designer pencil holder, perfect for holding paint brushes, colored pencils, art supplies, scissors, or anything else you can dream of for your desk. Keep the plastic lid to the cylinder and you can even enclose the top if you choose to use it to store other items.
